

## Travel Trailer Setup Checklist

### Before You Park

- ☐ Check water and electric at the site – Ensure hookups are working before committing to the site.
- ☐ Clear distance for slides – Confirm there's enough room for slide-outs.
- ☐ Park on level ground – Essential for proper appliance function and comfort.

### Securing and Leveling Your Travel Trailer

- ☐ Chock tires – Prevents movement once parked.
- ☐ Level camper – Use leveling blocks or a system for stability.
- ☐ X-Chock tires – Optional, but reduces bounce inside the trailer.
- ☐ Drop tow stabilizer – Adds front-end support.
- ☐ Disconnect hitch – Once stabilized, safely disconnect your tow vehicle.
- ☐ Store sway bars – Keeps them safe and out of the way.
- ☐ Drop stabilizers – Stabilize all four corners to prevent shaking.

### Hooking Up Power

- ☐ Ensure all electrical is off inside – Avoid power surges.
- ☐ Plug-in electric surge protector – Protects your RV from bad power.
- ☐ Connect electric to surge protector – Power up the RV safely.
- ☐ Lock protector in place – Prevents theft and keeps connection secure.

### Water and Sewer Connections

- ☐ Hook up water components – Regulator, filter, and drinking-safe hose.
- ☐ Hook up gray water to the sewer – Allows sink/shower water to drain.
- ☐ Drop in black water pods – Controls odor and breaks down waste.
- ☐ Turn on the water heater – Be sure it's full before powering on.
- ☐ Wash hands – Always good hygiene after handling hookups.

### Final Setup and Comfort

- ☐ Turn on propane – For cooking, heating, and fridge if needed.
- ☐ Ensure slides are clear of cords – Avoid pinching wires or damage.
- ☐ Open slides – Once clear, expand your living space.
- ☐ Turn on interior power – Lights, fans, and systems.
- ☐ Turn on fridges – Start cooling early for groceries.
- ☐ Secure all containers in storage – Stow gear to avoid clutter.

### Optional Extras

- ☐ Lay down outdoor rug – Adds comfort and keeps dirt out.
- ☐ Set up camp chairs and awning – Create a relaxing space.
- ☐ Turn on string lights or lanterns – For evening ambiance.
- ☐ Connect to campground Wi-Fi or hotspot – Get online if needed.
- ☐ Check quiet hours and local rules – Be a good neighbor.
